

Parking in NSW

Looking after your safety as a driver and a pedestrian



Community safety



Road Rule #197

Do not park on a nature strip



You cannot park on a nature strip (even if two wheels are on the road). This is for pedestrian access and safety.

Road Rule #208

Do not park within 3 metres of a median strip or double white lines



You cannot park within 3 metres of double white lines or a median strip unless a sign says otherwise. This is for traffic flow and safety.

Road Rule #208(2)

Do not parallel park the wrong way



Penalty exceeds \$128

You cannot park on the wrong side of the road facing oncoming traffic and other vehicles. You must park in the direction of the traffic flow. This is for safety when leaving the curb.

Road Rule #203(1)

Do not stop in a parking area for disabled



Penalty exceeds \$384

When the wheelchair logo appears on a sign or on a roadway, only vehicles displaying a valid Mobility Parking Scheme Authority issued by the RTA or other Disability Permits, may park on a length of road or in spaces indicated by the sign.

Road Rule #198

Do not block driveways



Penalty exceeds \$77

You cannot park on the road blocking a driveway or on the driveway (even your own) outside the property boundary. This is for access and pedestrian safety.

Road Rule #189

Do not double park



Penalty exceeds \$179

You cannot stop on a road next to other parked cars (even if you have your hazard lights on) unless you are about to park your vehicle. This is for traffic flow and safety.

Road Rule #195

Do not park near a bus stop



Penalty exceeds \$179

You cannot park within 20 metres before and 10 metres after a bus stop unless there are signs that permit parking. This is for the safety of bus passengers.

Road Rule #167

Do not stop in an area where a no stopping sign applies



Penalty exceeds \$179

You must not stop on a length of road to which a No Stopping sign applies. This is for the safety of other vehicles.
